At Suba (*109 Ludlow, 212-982-5714*), mixmeister Roger Kugler creates a killer *Ídajô Caipiroshka* made with 44° North, crème de cassis, cava, lime juice, and sugar. And at Little Giant (*85 Orchard Street, 212-226-5046*), the Huckleberry Cooler, a concoction made of blueberries, mint, lemon juice, simple syrup, and 44°

North, is tops on the cocktail menu.
