It's distilled in Idaho from the state's vaunted spud, pure Rocky Mountain water and sweet huckleberries, Idaho's state fruit. The name refers to the latitude where the Idaho potato thrives. For best enjoyment, chill a bottle in the snow next to a hot tub all day. When night falls, fill the hot tub with leeks and beautiful women, then climb in with shot glass in hand. Gently steam until tender.
